

Peter GROSSMANN - Nürnberg, Germany

Pianist Peter Grossmann was born in 1948 in Targu-Mures, Romania. He learned piano playing at the Music school of his hometown by Lady Charlotte Tróznér Erkel. His piano studies occurred at the National Music University in Cluj and Bucharest by Professor Gheorghe Halmos. He studied piano accompanying by Professor Suzana Szörényi in Bucharest.

After completing his studies he was accompanist for nine years by the chairs of singing and strings at the "Ciprian Porumbescu" College of Music (today National Music University) in Bucharest.

He was prize-winner in 1974 at the Zwickau International "Robert Schumann" Piano Competition. He was honoured twice with Diploma for excellent piano accompanying at the Moscow International Tchaikovsky Singing Competition in the years 1974 and 1978.

He is living in Germany since 1982. He was piano teaching at the Bamberg University and beginning of 1991, pianist accompanist at the Nürnberg College of Music. He was piano accompanying by the Köln, Würzburg, Frankfurt am Main colleges of music and he has been leading a song performing class by the Mannheim College of Music.

He was performing in nearly all European countries, in the United States, South Korea, Japan and La Reunion. At present he is leaving in Germany continuing his pianist activity. He was also creating an image of himself as a poems reciter, performing recitals of poetry and music in several towns in Germany and Romania.
